- II. To identify and address gaps for process improvement in the next year.

The questionnaire has been framed on the basis of NAAC guidelines. Students have rated the questions on a scale of 1 to 5. The summary, displayed on the college website, was also discussed in the IQAC meeting.

In all, 156 Postgraduate students and 72 undergraduate students have participated in the SSS -2021-22.

## **Result and Report:**

The overall student satisfaction survey results achieved for 2021-22 was 4.49 against
the set-target. These generally showed that students were satisfied with their study
experiences in Raj Narain College, Hajipur.
In the survey, more than 90% of the participants responded 'Strongly agree' and 'Agree'
which indicates an average of 80% to 90%. It shows that they were satisfied with the
services rendered by the teachers and the College.
With the implementation of the more improved measures, as implied in the Survey, the
college would be expecting better results in 2022-23.
More number of teachers needs to be appointed by the Government/ the University for
engaging in student- centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and
problem solving for enhanced learning experiences.
Further, the teachers and the institution need to facilitate more students in cognitive, social
and emotional growth and this score was 4 due to acute dearth of teachers.
