CERTIFICATE OF APPRECIATION FOR CLEAN & GREEN CAMPUS

This certificate of appreciation is being awarded to **Raj Narain College, Hajipur** for its excellent record in keeping the campus clean and green. The College has been consistent in maintaining green environment. It takes initiatives aimed at promoting biodiversity on the Campus and keeping it pollution free and plastic free.

On the basis of physical verification of the campus and records available there (for the year 2020-21 and 2021-22), some important measures taken by the college can be enumerated as under:

1. Van Mahotsav, an annual Tree Plantation Programme, is celebrated every year during the first week of July in collaboration with the Forest Department, Hajipur.
2. Important days like World Environment Day, World Bio-Diversity Day, Earth Day are commemorated by planting trees, and by organizing Seminar/ Webinars to make students sensitive to environmental issues.
3. Planting of trees forms an integral part of College Foundation Day, the Independence Day and the Republic Day Celebrations.
4. It is the responsibility of the Department of Botany to maintain a **Botanical Garden** where some rare herbs and plants are kept and maintained.
5. Campus cleanliness drives and making the Campus plastic-free have been made an essential constituent of 'Continuous Internal Assessment under Swachchha Bharat Abhiyan and Environment Sustainability in AECC-1, Semester 1 of Postgraduate CBCS Programmes.
6. Preparation of organic manures and vermin-composting of organic wastes is done by dedicated NSS volunteers. These fertilizers are regularly used for the enrichment of garden soil.
7. At the college use of Renewable Energy is a norm. Keeping in mind the benefits of solar energy to minimize the consumption of electricity as well as to reduce pollution, Raj Narain College has installed 10 KV Solar Panels. The said plant is located on the rooftop of the Arts Block and on the Administrative Block
8. Use of LED lights in the campus contributes to lesser power consumption.
9. Dustbins are placed at every corner and students are directed to ensure its proper use.
10. For water conservation, the college has developed 'Ground Water Recharge System' (total= 05) and 'Rain Water Harvesting system on the Campus.
11. Two soak-pits are functional on the Campus to recycle sewage.
