In 2018-19 we received two cases of academic anxiety.

In 2019-20 we received four cases of relationship problem, Emotional anxiety, suicidal thought and academic anxiety.

Due to the pandemic Covid -19 college was closed and there was a lockdown . In this Period we received phone calls from the students . They were anxious , fearful, stressed, feeling of loneliness and uncertainty.
